




Sprig Language

What is it?

Get started by trying these activities:

I Spy Letter Sounds

Play I Spy with your family. Use letters or letter sounds instead of colour.

"I spy something that starts with the "p" sound or I spy something that ends in the "k" sound."

Alternative: Play I Spy by looking for the actual letter in various environmental print.

Which One Doesn't Belong?

This game is perfect for a car ride or when you need to occupy a few minutes with your child. List 3-4 things of which all are related except one. Ask your child to figure out which one doesn't belong and why.

Ideas for Lists:

- Sun, oven, ice cube (sun and oven are hot, ice cube is cold)
- Acorn, bird, apple, apron (acorn, apple and apron all start with "A" and bird does not)
- Cat, gorilla, dog (cat and dog are pets, gorillas are wild)


Phonics Baskets

Create a "Phonics Basket" with your child by choosing a letter sound or sounds that you feel your child needs to focus on and having him/her fill a basket with objects found around the house that start with the sound(s). Once the basket has been filled, review and discuss the objects found and determine if they do indeed begin with the focus sound. Correct any errors and help find replacement objects.

Extension: Have your child draw a picture of the objects found and label some/all of them.

Creating Your Account


1. Go to spriglearning.com and click on the **Parent Account** button in the top right corner.




2. Create your account by entering your first/last name, email, a password that will be used when signing into your account and agreeing to Sprig's terms and conditions.

4. Select **Redeem my Child's Student Code**.



6. Confirm you have entered the correct student code information, click **Done**.
